### ***UN says Congo must stop deportations back to DRC***

- The United Nations demanded the Congo stop forcibly returning persons to the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC).
- The UN says that Congo-Brazzaville has deported more than 130,000 DRC nationals since April 4, 2014, creating an "acute humanitarian crisis".

### ***Rwandan rebels to turn themselves in to authorities in the DRC***

- Leaders of the Democratic Forces for the Liberation of Rwanda (FDLR) said that, in addition to the 100 rebels who have already turned themselves in, FDLR rebels will turn themselves in on June 9, in Kigogo in South Kivu.
- The rebels are members of the Hutu ethnic group and have been linked to the 1994 genocide in Rwanda where more than 800,000 Tutsi and moderate Hutu were killed.
- North Kivu's governor said the rebels will have a choice between returning to Rwanda or seeking asylum in the DRC.
